Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Writing Workshop – Introduce the writing process.
Spelling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify, read and spell words with Short Vowels (a,i).
Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify subjects and predicates correctly. • Editing simple sentences using proofreading marks. • Write words in alphabetical order.
Social Studies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What is a community? • How we learn to be a kind, respectful and responsible community member?
Assessments	<p>Formative Assessments are done throughout the week. These are scored with a (√ +, √, √-) Students will begin taking different forms of assessments to determine their individual learning paths and to influence plans for instruction. Refer to your child's binder for study guides and review classwork.</p>
