Math	Lesson 8 - Double Digit Subtraction
ELA (English Language Arts)	<i>Bugs in Their Ecosystems</i> During this unit, your student will become an expert on bugs - and one particular bug/research topic specifically. This week, we are learning about our first research question (RQ#1) - Classification: What kind of bug is this? How do you know? Learning about informational text. Spelling - practicing words with blends, double consonants, and ending in -ck (Pumpkin, Costume, Happen, Brick, Knock, Block, Trick, Treat, Truck, Hammock, Challenge Word: About)
